CYO ATHLETICS PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT

This Code of Conduct applies to all parents/guardians of athletes involved in our organization's youth sports activities

I AGREE: "THE GAME IS FOR THE KIDS"

- I will respect the rules of the game and the policies of the CYO league.
- I will respect the officials and their authority before, during and after games and will never confront officials and/or coaches before, during or after the game. If I have a concern, I will take time to speak with my child's coach at an agreed upon time and place. If I have further concerns beyond my conversations with the coach, I will contact my child's Athletic Director.
- I understand only my child's Athletic Director may contact CYO. I may not at anytime contact CYO or any other school or program regarding my concerns. I must go through my Athletic Director.
- I will inform the coach of any physical disability or ailment that may affect the safety of my child or the safety of others.
- I (and my guests) will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any official, coach, player or parent such as booing and taunting; or using profane language or gestures.
- I will not encourage any behaviors or practices that would endanger the health and well-being of the athletes. I will teach my child to play by the rules and to resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility or violence.
- I will never ridicule or yell at my child or other participants for making a mistake or losing a competition.
- I understand CYO events are free from drugs, tobacco and alcohol and I will refrain from their use at all sports events.
- I will refrain from coaching my child or other players during games.

I ALSO AGREE THAT IF I FAIL TO ABIDE BY THE AFOREMENTIONED RULES AND GUIDELINES, I WILL BE SUBJECT TO DISCIPLINARY ACTION THAT COULD INCLUDE, BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO THE FOLLOWING:

- Verbal warning by Official, Head Coach, Gym Director, or CYO Administration.
- Parental game(suspension with written documentation of incident kept on file in the CYO Athletic Office.
- Game forfeiture through the Official or CYO Administration.
- Parental season suspension.

I UNDERSTAND IF I AM REMOVED FROM A GAME FOR UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT, I WILL BE AUTOMATICALLY SUSPENDED FOR AT LEAST THE REMAINDER OF THE SEASON, PLAYOFFS AND CHAMPIONSHIPS. REFUSAL TO LEAVE WILL RESULT IN FORFEITURE OF MY CHILD'S GAME AND I WILL BE SUSPENDED FOR 15 MONTHS FROM THE DATE OF INFRACTION.

CYO ATHLETICS PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

The CYO Athletic Program is designed to be representative of the Christian character in life. As Christians, we are constantly challenged to better ourselves. In team sports we strive for improvement both as individuals and as a group. The development of such values is the primary objective of CYO Athletics. CYO Athletics is the arena in which the youngster practices the principles of Christian values and also provides opportunities for healthy growth and development. Within this arena the coaches, directors, and participants must manifest and exemplify the ideals of a Christian life.

I will:

- Respect decisions made by contest officials.
- Be a role model by positively supporting teams and by not shouting instructions or criticism to the players, coaches or officials.
- Make no derogatory comments or gestures to officials or league administrators, players, coaches, or parents of the opposing team
- Honor the Game and respect the game, by playing hard and refusing to bend the rules to win
- Honor the Game and respect the game, their opponents, by playing “fierce and friendly”
- Honor the Game and respect the game, the officials, by showing respect even when we disagree
- Honor the Game and respect the game, our teammates, by being committed to them on and off the field
- Honor the Game and respect the game, our self, by holding ourselves to a high standard even when others do

All players are expected to respect the rules of the games, the officials who administer the rules, and their decisions; respect opponents and acknowledge them for striving to do their best; and be an intense competitor on the field, while behaving in a respectable manner at all times.

Mission Dolores Academy Athletic Program Student Athlete & Parent(s)/Guardian Contract

Participation in Mission Dolores Academy athletic program is a privilege and honor. Students who wished to take an advantage of the opportunities to be a part of MDA athletic program must show the commitment and responsibility by maintaining good attendance, good grades, outstanding behavior, and honor the MDA & CYO code of conduct. Each student athlete's academics progress will be monitor frequently. Failure to comply with the MDA student athlete academic policy and/or this contract will result in disciplinary action and/or dismissal from the team.

Academics

It is recognized that the primary function of the school is to provide each student with a basic education. We as MDA believe that education comes before athletic programs. Therefore, Mission Dolores Academy maintains an academic eligibility policy.

Athletic Activities

Students from grade three through eight may participate in the CYO sports program. Games and practices are held outside of school hours. The number of teams and sports offered will be determined by:

- The number of coaches
- The number of students who desire to participate

Students who participate in the sports program must:

- Pay the required charge for league fees and equipment
- **Maintain a GPA of 2.0 in core classes (Math, ELA, Science, SS) and have a passing grade in all classes.**
- Have satisfactory standing in the areas of effort and behavior
- **If a student is absent without excusable reason, he/she may not participate in scheduled game on that day.**
- If a student receives a suspension, that student may not participate in the next game, even if it is a championship game.

Grade check will be done using Quarterly report cards and mid-quarter progress report.

- Report Cards Date: November, January, March, and May.
- Progress Report Date: Weekly on Wednesday

If student is failing after the progress reports check, he/she will be put on two weeks probation after the date of progress report check. While the student-athlete is on probation, he/she must attend tutoring three times a week to bring the grades to passing. Failure to bring the grades to passing after the two weeks probation, he/she will be suspended from playing for the season.

The Principal/Asst. Principal reserves the right to disqualify a student from the Sports Program for a given time if that is deemed warranted by the student's behavior or academic performance.

Hazing

A person is guilty of hazing...when, in the course of the student's entry into or affiliation with any team or club, he/she intentionally or recklessly engages in conduct which creates a risk of physical injury, emotional harm, threatened harm, harassment, ridicule, criticism and causing the victim to damage public or private property. Any type of initiation or hazing is prohibited. Athletes who violate the hazing rules will be subject to severe discipline and may be subjected to criminal action.

Athletes Responsibility

I understand that my primary responsibility is to my academics and I must keep up my grades to be eligible for sports. An F or GPA under 2.0 after grades check, will immediately place me on athletic probation.

I will be supportive of other teammates, coaches, parents and officials. I understand that I am a very visible representative of my school and as such I will at all times represent the ethics and values of Mission Dolores Academy on and off the field.

Uniforms/Registration Fee

I am responsible for the uniform and equipment I am provided. Uniforms must be returned neat and clean in a day or two of the end of the season. If the uniform is NOT returned in good condition by the assigned date at the end of the season, my parents and I agree to pay a replacement fee of \$60 per item. Any unpaid sports registration fees will be added on to student's tuition fee. Students will not be able to participate in any sports program if there is an outstanding debt.

Understand and fully agree to fully abide by the terms of this contract. If any reasons athlete fail to obey and fulfill the agreement of this contract will result in possibility of suspension from athletic program by the Principal/Asst. Principal and Athletic Director of MDA. As the parent(s)/guardian by signing this contract, I give the right to MDA to take any appropriate actions to discipline the student-athlete.
